

M3 Meeting Minutes

October 1, 2012

ATTENDANCE:

Pete opened the meeting about 7:00 by reviewing old business.

OLD BUSINESS:

- 1) Club Hats are here. We purchased 100 hats. They are \$15 each. See Andy Kunz to get yours. We need to show our support - buy your hat(s) and wear them when flying at our field, when traveling to other fields, and at events like Toledo. Hats are in two sizes and there should be one to fit you.

- 3) Treasurer's Report - After paying all outstanding bills (taxes, insurance, etc.) we have \$5289 in the account. We expect to clear about \$900 more after they finish reconciling receipts and disbursements for the IMAC event that was held this weekend.

NEW BUSINESS:

- 1) This coming Saturday and Sunday, Oct 6 & 7, we will have two days of fun flying with a camp-out overnight. Bring a few planes and a sleeping bag!
- 2) The need to seal the runway is now a high priority due to cracks around the perimeter and the approaching winter. Mike will investigate having it sealed ASAP.
- 3) The annual May Builder Contest will include a One Design event. Andy has arranged for discounted Comet Sparky short-kits from Bob Holman by doing a club bulk-buy. By the close of the meeting we had about 15 people signed up for kits at a 20% discount. Andy will send out an e-mail this week to invite more participation and update on the pricing. He will order them about the 12th.
- 4) After much discussion about what to do as a "club thing" over the winter to encourage participation at the meetings, a motion was made to purchase a 12' Telemaster kit and build it as part of the meetings. Andy will make his heated garage available for the meetings and construction

area. His home is close to the field (next exit heading north on I-72, White Heath Road) and easy to locate.
