

M3 Meeting Minutes

July 7, 2014

ATTENDANCE:

The meeting was held at the hangar. Pete called it to order about 7:00.

TREASURER'S REPORT:

Pete presented the Treasurer's Report for Chris, who was not in attendance.

- 1) Events have done well. Recent additions include about \$3100 from the AeroTow, about \$340 from IMAC, and nearly \$300 from the Truck/Earth Mover event.
- 2) The July 3 Open House netted the club almost \$600. Attendees donated \$90 to the Monticello Fireworks Committee, which will be match by \$90 from the club.
- 3) Horizon Hobby will be paying taxes on the property. This relieves a huge burden on the club, and allows us to use the event proceeds for site maintenance and improvements. The result will be much improved facilities for M3 members and Horizon Academy events, with much less stress on the club officers. Thank you, Horizon!
- 4) Runway repair and sealing has been billed at \$2400 + crack repairs. Some of the runway expenses will be paid as AMA and club memberships in lieu of cash.
